

The message of the Leader following the terrorist incident in Shahcheragh Shrine - 27 /Oct/ 2022

Following the terrorist incident yesterday in the Holy Shrine of Hazrat Aḥmad b. Mūsā b. Ja'far, peace be upon them, which led to the martyrdom and injury of dozens of innocent men, women and children, the Supreme Leader of the Islamic Revolution, Ayatollah Khamenei, sent a message of condolence to the families of the people of Shiraz and the Iranians emphasizing: The security agencies and the judiciary, as well as the activists in the field of thought and [Islamic] missionaries, as well as dear people, must be united against the trend that allows disregard and disrespect for people's lives, their security, and their sanctities.

The text of the message of the Islamic Revolution Supreme Leader is as follows:
